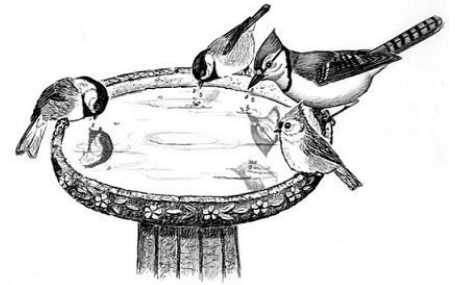


Love Gardening? Join Us!
